



Guidelines and Rules for Miss Min-I-Kota Pinto Revised for 2011 Contest!

- Miss Min-I-Kota Pinto is a representative and ambassador for the Min-I-Kota charter of the Pinto Horse Association of America. She is to have general knowledge of the Pinto Horse and Min-I-Kota Pinto Horse Association in order to properly promote Min-I-Kota to potential members. She will work under the direction of the Min-I-Kota Board of Directors, the royalty chairperson(s), and alongside the Min-I-Kota Youth Royalty Members.
- Must be 17 years old on the first day of the contest, and no older than 25 on January first of the contest year.
- Must be single, never married and never borne a child.
- She or her family must own or lease a registered pinto horse, pony or miniature.
- The woman chosen as Miss Min-I-Kota Pinto is EXPECTED to attend all Min-I-Kota sponsored functions (general membership meetings, shows, and banquet) as well as represent Min-I-Kota at various other events which could include, but not limited to various expos, Iowa Horse Fair, Minnesota Horse Expo, PtHA National Convention, parades and the Pinto World & Congress shows. If she cannot attend a club sponsored event a written statement is to be sent to the royalty chairperson(s) stating her reason(s) for her absence.
- Must be a member in good standing of Min-I-Kota Pinto Association the year preceding the contest year, the contest year, and the year of her reign.
- A member in good standing is defined for the purpose as: current Min-I-Kota and PtHA dues are paid, no censures against member with Min-I-Kota or PtHA, and all levies, fines, show fees or other fees and payments associated with Min-I-Kota and PtHA must be current.
- Contestants must conduct themselves in a manner befitting the title of Miss Min-I-Kota Pinto. In acting in the official capacity, as Miss Min-I-Kota Pinto, the use of alcohol and/or tobacco products in public is strictly prohibited.
- Applications are to be postmarked to the designated royalty advisor by September 1st of the contest year.
- Coronation will take place at the annual charter awards banquet.

*Equitation, speech, personal interview & written exam will be given at the determination of the royalty chairperson(s).

Upon being crowned Miss Min-I-Kota Pinto, she will receive:

- A banner to keep stating her title and the year of her reign.
- Any donated gifts presented at coronation.
- Traveling crowns
- Traveling sashes in various colors
- Traveling belt buckle
