Min-I-Kota Pinto Glory Versatility Award

The Glory Versatility Award is a traveling award donated by Tom and Jaci Zellmer in honor of their pony, Tommy's Glory, who became the 1st Stock Type Pony in the nation to earn a Supreme Championship. This award is given each year to the pony with the highest number of points in Min-I-Kota Pinto by competing in seven different classes of their choice. Currently, the pony on the trophy is painted to match Tommy's Glory, but once a pony has won the award three times, the pony will be painted to match the winning pony and the trophy will be retired.
